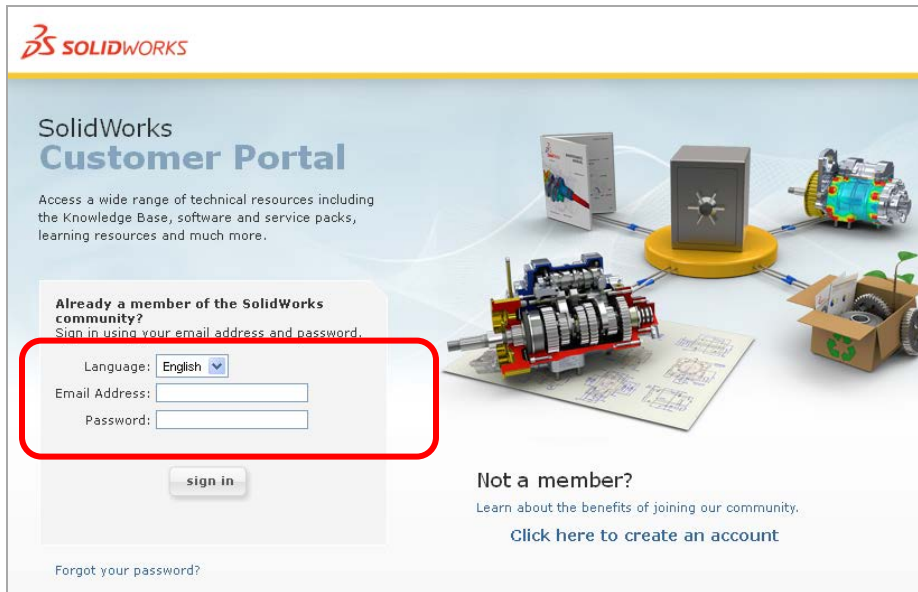

5. Login to Customer Portal

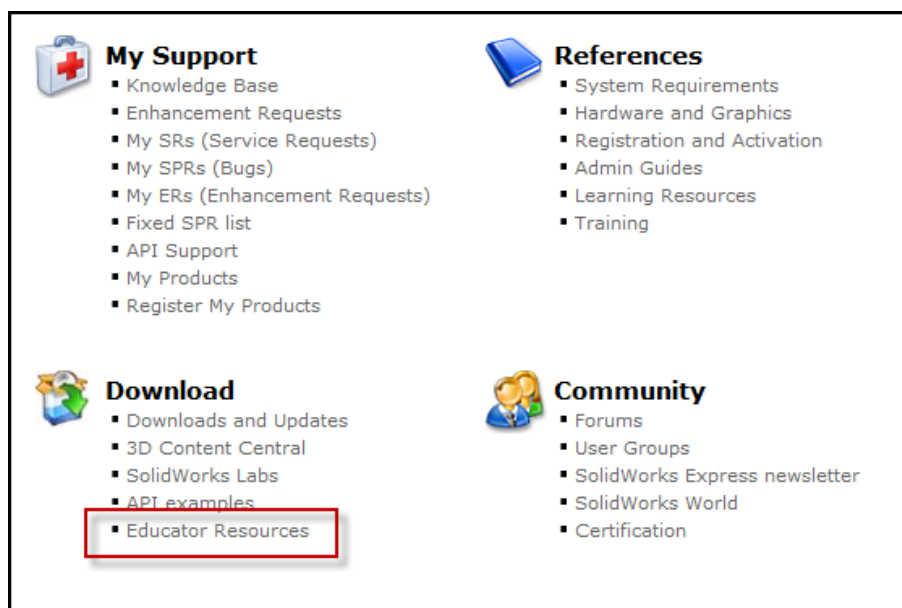
